This course is designed to provide law enforcement officers with information on the vast variety of weapons that are available to criminals in our society. It will take a detailed look into types of firearms, knives, improvised weapons, and hidden threats that can be used to assault or possibly kill law enforcement officers. This course will also provide information critical to officer survival. It will discuss the physical, psychological, and emotional techniques and strategies to winning lethal confrontations. It is imperative that we learn and adapt to their new tricks and techniques that endanger the law enforcement officers across the country. This course will focus on other officer safety issues and examine tricks and techniques that criminals often use.

Learning Objectives:

At the conclusion of the course, participants should be able to do the following:

- Understand deception / stalling techniques
- Find hidden weapons and contraband on the body
- Locate hidden weapons and contraband in vehicles and homes
- How to escape from controlled custody
- Disarming techniques used on law enforcement officers
- Familiar with how criminals that train with firearms, edged weapons, and hidden threats
- Knowledgeable on the manufacturing crude weapons
- Explosives and Booby-Traps recognition
- Using verbal and non-verbal communications to coordinate an attack
- Use of the internet for gathering intelligence on law enforcement officers
- The four stages of building the path for a truthful confession
