Description

The City of Hico, Texas is accepting applications for a full-time TCOLE certified Peace Officer. Assigned duties will be split between working at the local school campus and general patrol duties for the city.

Duties at the school include but are not limited to:

Provide law enforcement and police services to the school, school grounds and areas adjacent to the school. Investigate allegations of criminal incidents per police department policies and procedures. Enforce state and local laws and ordinances.

Work to prevent juvenile delinquency through close contact and positive relationships with students.

Establish and maintain a close partnership with school administrators in order to provide for a safe school environment.

Be visible within the school community. Attend and participate in school functions. Build working relationships with the school's staff as well as with student and parent groups.

Work with guidance counselors and other student support staff to assist students and to provide services to students involved in situations where referrals to service agencies are necessary. Assist in conflict resolution efforts.

Initiate interaction with students in the classroom and general areas of the school building. Promote the profession of police officer and be a positive role model. Increase the visibility and accessibility of police to the school community.

In addition there will be general patrol duties such as patrolling streets, answering calls, and investigating offenses.

No arrests in the last 5 years for any offense of a class "A or B" misdemeanor

No felony arrests

No drug convictions
