- ✓ Lateral entry incumbents must either be currently employed as a Police Officer in Texas or other state or federal jurisdiction acceptable to the university or have less than 12 month break in service
- ✓ Licensed in Texas as a Basic Police Officer or above with a minimum of two years of post-academy police experience; or licensed as a police officer in another state or federal jurisdiction, qualify for licensure as a Basic Police Officer or above under the rules and regulations of the TCOLE, and have two or more years of post-academy police experience
