Issue/Scenario: You have just arrested a person of the opposite sex for a traffic warrant on a traffic stop. After releasing the vehicle to another occupant, you prepare to transport the prisoner to jail.

What must you do when transporting prisoners of the opposite sex?

Discussion: Officers should contact dispatch and advise them of the location from which they are transporting the prisoner and the current vehicle mileage.

Officers should take the most direct route to the jail as possible or advise the dispatcher of an alternate route.

Advise the dispatcher of any delays or detours during the transport.

Advise the dispatcher of the arrival at the jail and ending mileage.

This process ensures the ability of officers to defend themselves against unwarranted accusations of inappropriate behavior.
