Issue/Scenario: You have just responded to a call at the High School. The SRO there has made two arrests. One, a twenty-year-old for loitering on the school grounds after having received a Criminal Trespass warning last week. The other is a 15-year-old that was found with marijuana in their locker by a teacher doing routine locker searches. You determine that both arrests are appropriate and decide to transport both to the department for processing.

Can you transport both together in the same car?

Discussion: No.

Department policy prohibits transportation of a juvenile and adult in the same vehicle unless arrested in the same criminal event.

Contact the dispatcher for another transport unit or determine if the SRO can leave the facility to do a transport.
