Courses Focus on Individual Leadership Skills and Their Application in Specific Assignments


Track "B"

LECOP Course Requirements





LECOP Other Requirements

- **1.** Completion of Ten (10) TPCA Courses (6 Required, 4 Electives)
- 2. No Timeline Requirement (Due to Department Cost and Absence Concerns)
- 3. No Additional Cost
- 4. Recommendation of the Chief Administrator



LECOP Completion Process

- **1.** Applicants Complete 10 Courses As Prescribed.
- 2. Applicants Will Submit an Approved Application to the TPCA Training Director.
- 3. Application Will Include:
 - A list of the classes completed,
 - The date each class was completed,
 - The Applicant's name, Agency and TCOLE PID,
 - The Signature of the Applicant's Agency Chief Administrator Acknowledging Their Recommendation.
- 4. Upon Receipt of the Application, the TPCA Training Director will Confirm the Completion of the Classes and the Agency Chief Administrator's Recommendation.
- 5. Upon Confirmation of Qualifications, A Certificate Acknowledging the Completion of the LECOP Will Be Provided at No Cost.
