**Texas Law Enforcement Peer Network**

Join a team dedicated to community service, quality of life, and committed to the importance of family time. You can make a real difference while being part of the solution. The City of Belton is currently accepting applications for a non-sworn Peer Support Regional Director position. The Belton Police Department has been selected as one of the regional hubs for the newly created Texas Law Enforcement Peer Network. This position will coordinate the development of a peer support system for law enforcement officers in the Central region of Texas. Duties include: recruiting law enforcement officers throughout the region to serve as volunteer peers; providing training for the peers; administrative support for the Texas Law Enforcement Peer Network, promoting the resources available through the peer support software app, keeping records for the activities of the peer support initiatives in the region, and other duties in support of law enforcement wellness.

A high school diploma or equivalent is required. Associates degree or higher is preferred. Coursework or training in criminal justice, counseling, traumatic events, therapy, or related fields is desirable. Strong presentation, problem solving, and critical thinking skills are required. Previous experience working with victims of traumatic experiences, critical incidents, suicide prevention, retired law enforcement, or a police chaplain is preferred, but not required. This is a grant funded position currently funded through the Fall of 2023.
