The expanding community of Uvalde, Texas, is seeking an Assistant Chief of Police. The city of nearly 16,200 in population, is located at the junction of US 90 and US 83, and the county seat of Uvalde County. The city's extra territorial jurisdiction (ETJ) boundaries covers over 5.47 square miles.

The Assistant Chief performs at a highly skilled professional level and is considered an upper level/command position. In this role the Assistant Chief shall have command and management responsibility, under the general direction and supervision of the Police Chief. This position will be responsible for leading and guiding all operations of the department including law enforcement, investigations, training, and community relations.

The department includes 3 lieutenants, 4 corporals, 5 corporal detectives, 6 sergeants, 21 patrol officers, 11 telecommunication operators, and 6 non-sworn personnel, who provide 24-hour emergency and non-emergency services to the Uvalde community.
