JOB SUMMARY:

The Police Officer, under general supervision, provides specialized professional law enforcement skills by giving service, information and aid to citizens as circumstances require, preventing crime, suppressing disturbances, investigating criminal offenses, and arresting offenders. This position is identified as a Campus Security Authority (CSA). A CSA reports non-personally identifying information to the Department of Public Safety related to incidents that fall within the Jeanne Clery Act. Working knowledge of and completion of annual training on the Jeanne Clery Act is required.

REQUIRED EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE/SKILLS:

High school diploma or equivalent combination of education and experience.

One year of related experience.

Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) basic certification. Must have a State of Texas class "C" vehicle operator's license or ability to obtain within 30 days of employment.

Other Requirements:

All system university police will be required to meet minimum licensing standard requirements as required by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) § 217.1.

Work beyond normal office hours and/or work on weekends.

Must successfully pass psychological evaluation, physical examination, and complete background investigation to include but not limited to driving history, criminal background, and credit history.

PREFERRED:

One (1) year or more experience as a Police Officer with a city, county or state agency, with preference to campus police officer experience.

Strong written and verbal communications skills.

Prior training in basic first aid/CPR.

Must pass a general physical exam and a psychological exam.

Must pass a drug test
