- Five years command level or supervisory experience for a law enforcement agency.
- Texas Peace Officer license and a Master Peace Officer certificate issued by Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education (TCLEOSE).
- Valid Texas driver license; bondable as required by Texas Education Code 37.081(h).
- Knowledge of federal and state laws.
- Ability to manage budget and personnel.
- Knowledge of all aspects of Police Department operations, including criminal investigations, report writing, and criminal law.
