SUBJECT: TPCA Legislative Committee Report

On August 28, 2024, the Legislative Committee held a meeting to discuss a variety of legislative topics and receive several updates. The meeting was hosted at the Texas Municipal League office on Rutherford Lane in Austin. Over 32 people attended with an opportunity to provide input for a forthcoming TPCA Legislative Agenda.

Despite the vast topics discussed, we have identified several areas of focus listed below:

- Funding Seeking to sustain and grow the funding for policing, but specifically both the LEMIT and LEOSE funds.
- Accreditation Promoting and ensuring integrity and credibility in Texas
 policing is an overarching mission for TPCA. Accreditation is part of that
 mission.
- Mental Health The impact of mental health in our society continues to grow and creates challenges for the entire criminal justice system.
- Emergency Detention and Transport Expand the law to allow Emergency Medical Services personnel to complete Emergency Detention Orders (EDO) to include mental health professionals and others into the EDO process.
- Taser 10 Change the penal code to remove the new taser 10 from being recognized as a deadly weapon under the description of a firearm due to the firing mechanism. The appropriate designation is a less lethal weapon to promote de-escalation and reduce the need for deadly force.
- School Safety Despite the extensive school safety provisions created last session, we must be diligent and aggressive in ensuring the continued safety of our schools.

- **Delta 8 & 9** Make recommendations to prohibit or at least further regulate the sale of related products and suggest legislation to stop retailers who market these products to children.
- Marihuana TPCA will continue opposing the efforts to de-criminalize marihuana.
- Lobbying by Municipal Employees Support legislation that blocks any attempt to prohibit the authority to use public funds to communicate with legislators and state agencies as well as pay membership dues to organizations that hire lobbyists.

Numerous other topics were discussed as legislative concerns to include some such as Squatting, Children Without Placement (CWOP), Glock Switches, Reserve Officers, Asset Forfeiture, Bail Reform, Enhanced Penalties for Evading, and more.

Further discussion included processes for bill analysis and selection of a Chiefs Day at the Capitol in late January or early February.

As we move toward the 89th Session of the Texas Legislature, the committee will continue to work further our agenda and processes.
