General Description:

This is a newly reformed department and looking for mature 2 (two) police officers who can work with limited supervision.

This is a small city that is growing with new housing. You must be able to handle working in all weather conditions. You will be patrolling the city which includes about a mile of I-69/US 59 and will enforce all laws to include city ordinances and traffic infractions. The Chief of Police is looking for the kind of police officer who can look back on their law enforcement career and be proud of the time spent serving this community. The City of Woodbranch wants to have a police department! They want this agency to thrive and are supportive! This is YOUR chance to make an impact.

Under general supervision, provides responsive and courteous police services in the protection of life and property through the enforcement of laws and ordinances, generally consisting of routine patrol, interventions, assistance, investigations and traffic regulation duties.

A Patrol Officer applicant must meet the following minimum requirements;

- Be 21 years of age.
- Be a citizen of the United States.
- Have a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- Possess a Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) Officer Certification.
- Have and maintain a clear and valid Texas Class C or higher driver's license and an acceptable driving record.
- Must have received an honorable discharge from Military Service.
- Must have satisfactory results of a background and employment screening check consisting of no convictions of a criminal offense above a Class C misdemeanor.
- Applicants must pass a physical exam, psychological evaluation, and drug screening.
- Applicant must have one-year full time patrol experience with a municipal or county agency. This year requirement may be waived depending on the applicant's maturity level and other factors.
- Must be able to work shift work consisting of weekends and holidays.
